As we continue to phase in the Next Generation Assessments for Ohio, we will be testing students at periodic times during the month of March and April. This e-mail provides all the details regarding upcoming test dates and changes to bell schedules at the Main Campus.

Every effort has been made to develop schedules that maximize instructional time while providing a targeted test environment for students to focus on these tests, needed for graduation.

End of course assessments will be given in the following areas:

- English 9
- English 10
- Algebra I
- Geometry
- Biology
- American History
- American Government

In addition to the end of course assessments listed above, all juniors will be taking the following assessment:

- ACT Test

Thursday, March 16 PRE-TEST ADMINISTRATION/TEST PREP

- Students currently enrolled in CP English 10 or Honors English 10
- Students currently classified as juniors (you can check HAC if you are unsure)

Students noted above will report to testing rooms no later than 8:05 am. Students will work through pre-test administration as well as test prep sessions to prepare for the upcoming English AIR Assessment and ACT.

This is a REQUIRED session for the students noted above.

- **Is NOT currently enrolled in CP English 10**
- **Is NOT currently enrolled in Honors English 10**

- **Is NOT taking part in OGT Testing that day**

- **ELA 10 – Parts 1 and 2**

- **Is NOT currently enrolled in CP English 10**
- **Is NOT currently enrolled in Honors English 10**
- **Is NOT currently classified as a Junior per HAC**
- **Is NOT taking part in OGT Testing that day**

ELA 10 Test Notes:

- Students currently enrolled in CP English 10/Honors English 10 will report to testing rooms no later than 8:05 am.
- All students will take part 1 from 8:05 am – 10:15 – 10 minutes of administrative time followed by 120 minutes of test time
- All test takers will be in lunch from 10:15 – 11:05
- All students will take part 2 will take place from 11:15 am – 1:25 pm – 10 minutes of administrative time followed by 120 minutes of test time.
- Students must be present for the full testing session

ACT Test Notes

- Students currently classified as juniors (you can check HAC if you are unsure) will report to testing rooms no later than 8:05 am.
- The ACT Test consists of four sections with a break midway through the test:
 - English – 45 minutes – 8:15 am – 9:00 am
 - Math – 60 minutes – 9:00 am – 10:00 am
 - BREAK – 10 minutes – 10:00 am – 10:10 am
 - Reading – 35 minutes – 10:10 am – 10:45 am
 - Science – 35 minutes – 10:45 am – 11:20 am
- Juniors will be dismissed for the day at the conclusion of the final testing block
- Students must be present for the full testing session
- Students approved by ACT to receive accommodations will be contacted regarding their specific testing dates.
