Emergency Medical Form: A pre-populated EMF for your student was sent to your home in a recent mailing. Please take some time to carefully review the auto-call information/phone number at the top of the form and also the contact information in the center. If you find there are changes to be made, please mark them directly on the form. **You can bring your completed Emergency Medical Form to the Orientation Session.** Please *DO NOT* return to coaches/directors/athletic trainers. We encourage you to make copies of the completed form as often times needs arise throughout the year for additional EMF's.

Students that miss Orientation will have a make-up day early in the school year.

2018 - 2019 BELL SCHEDULE

Lakota East Main Campus will utilize the modified block schedule for the 2018-2019 school year. The hours for the school day will be: 8:05 am – 2:40 pm. The modified block schedule includes a standard, six-bell schedule on Monday, Tuesday and Friday. Each bell will last approximately fifty minutes. There will be three lunch rotations during the fourth bell, during which students will have a 50-minute class, 35-minute lunch and a 20-minute intervention period.

On Wednesdays, students will meet in first, third and fifth bells for approximately 90 minutes. On Thursdays, they will meet in second, fourth and sixth bells for approximately 90 minutes. There will also be a 45-minute Extra Help Bell (XH) on Wednesday and Thursday. This XH Bell will provide all students with the opportunity to receive additional intervention and enrichment.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES

School supplies are driven by the courses taken. Teachers will provide information about what you need for their classes during the first weeks of school. All students should plan to bring a notebook and something to write with the first day.
